

SPONSOR A COMMUNITY DRINKING WELL



Many of the Bedouin living in small communities surrounding Mount Sinai in Egypt have no drinking water. The water they purchase from tankers for general use makes the people ill if they use it for drinking. They either have to purchase it in bottles, which is too expensive, or go to a neighbour's well. They may have to travel some distance and as many as 50 people can use one well, putting great strain on it. The Bedouin do not charge for use of their water, but their wells are becoming dry with the lack of rainfall and overuse by desperate families. The Bedouin do not have sufficient funds to deepen these wells themselves and have asked for help from the Makhad Trust.

The Project
